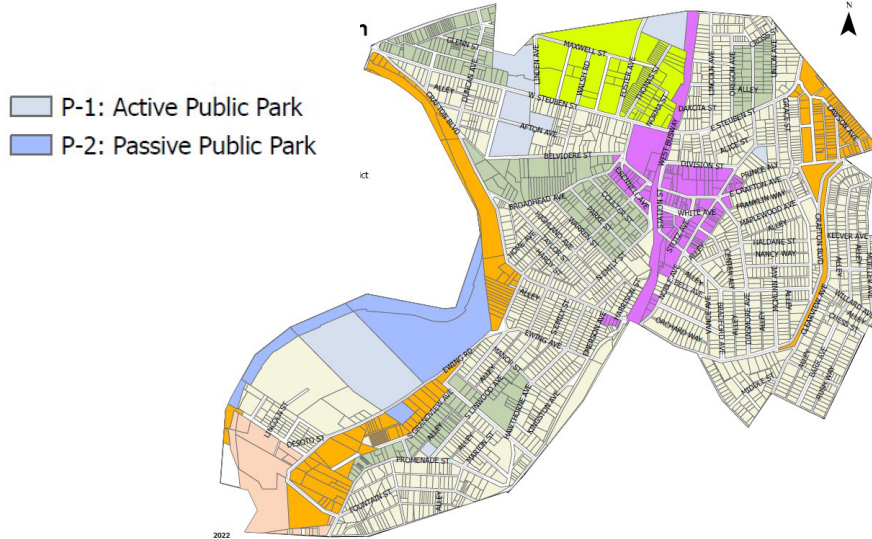


ACTIVE AND PASSIVE PUBLIC PARK (P-1, P-2)



CHARACTER OVERVIEW

The purpose of the P-1 Active Public Park District is to designate publicly owned lands which are reserved for active recreation in public parks and to establish regulations for the use of land for public park purposes. The purpose of the P-2 Passive Public Park District is to designate publicly owned lands which are preserved as open space or reserved for passive public park purposes and to establish regulations for the use of land for these public park purposes.

BUILDING FORM

- In addition to naturalized areas, the P-1 permits facilities that serve active recreation activities like tennis courts and swimming pools.
- The P-2 accommodates naturalized areas with additional built amenities like gazebos and picnic areas.



USES

A variety of active and passive recreational uses. Amenities like concessions, restrooms, and bleachers are permitted as accessory uses in the P-1.
